

(1) About Eikei University of Hiroshima (EUH)

Eikei University of Hiroshima (EUH) is a public university located in the heart of Hiroshima city and established in April 2021. Our principles are "independently creating the society that should be possible in the future" and, to that end, "independently finding problems drafting solutions, demonstrating leadership while collaboration with others to execute our plans to create new social values". By our practical education, student will gain digital skills methodologies of logical thinking, design thinking, and systematic thinking, taking liberal arts subjects as well as project-based learning to engage in solving actual social issues and experiential / practical program including volunteer activities and internship. In addition, two notable world heritage sites in Hiroshima, the the Atomic Bomb Dome and Itsukushima Shrine, offer extra educational experiences from the perspectives of peace, culture, and history in Japan.



Advanced courses


Advanced courses are categorized into 3 perspectives (People, Prosperity, and Planet) and are to be selected as electives according to the students' interests.

Hiroshima Prefecture is surrounded by both mountains and sea, and you will feel the charm of each season.



As for spring, we highly recommend cherry blossom viewing. Every year, people enjoy the coming of spring at Peace Memorial Park. During the Golden Week holidays, a city-wide event called the "Flower Festival" is also held.

When the rainy season ends, fireworks festival are held in various locations. You can also enjoy outdoor activities such as swimming or camping.

Since the climate is comfortable in the fall, it is the best time to take a pleasure trip. You can see the beautiful fall foliage in towns and natural parks.

It begins to snow from around Christmas. In the northern part of Hiroshima, you can enjoy winter sports such as skiing or snowboarding.

(2) Transportation

With the longest electric tramway route in Japan, Hiroshima Electric Railway streetcars offer easy access and convenience. Bus services and JR trains are also available.



(3) Sightseeing Destinations

Miyajima and the Atomic Bomb Dome, World Heritage sites and many other historic buildings are in Hiroshima. In addition, there are many sightseeing places with an abundance of nature.
