7 weeks: Summer B Date of Arrival: June 26/27, 2023 (TBC)-UGuelph to arrange airport group pickup with group of 5 or more students arriving at the same time.

Date of Departure: August 19/20, 2023 (TBC)-UGuelph to arrange one airport drop off to same group of students

Program Start Date: July 3, 2023 (Check-in date, Orientation, Campus tours, academic orientation, etc.)

7 Week ELCP Program End Date: August 18, 2023



Program Objectives:

- Improve academic English language skills in areas of: speaking and listening and academic writing
- Enhance knowledge of Canadian culture, inter-cultural communication

Course Description:

Program: first week of arrival will be Orientation for the English Language Certificate Program students:

- Orientation-Campus tours, City of Guelph tours, Academic orientation, What to expect, Cultural shock, social activity, etc.
- English language Placement Test
- Students will be placed into the English Language Certificate Program with diverse student class

Program: Second week of arrival, classes begin for the English Language Certificate Program:

- Weekly classes
- 4 classes in Reading, Writing/Grammar, Listening, and Speaking
- One hour of Conversation Tutor with university students per week
- ELP Buddy Program with University of Guelph students (1-2 hours per week)
- Learning materials (textbooks sold separately)
- Activities, volunteering, and social events (face-to-face)
- Airport transportation (return) with 5 or more students
- Monthly local bus pass
- Athletic membership
- Library access
- Unlimited Internet access on campus
- Participate in all the activities, peer support, conversation tutors, etc.
- Engaged program on campus: classrooms located across the campus/same classrooms as domestic students; same eating facilities; same library facilities; etc.
- Highly qualified instructors
- Small classes
- Balanced in-class/out-of-class support program
- Many opportunities to meet and engage with Canadian university students





Cost should include:

- 7 weeks academic English program for 20 hours per week plus one week of Student Orientation
- Conversation tutors (minimum 1 additional hour per week x 7 = 7 additional hours)
- Buddy Program (1-2 additional hours per week)
- Some activities, volunteering, and social events
- Airport transportation (return) with 5 or more students
- Monthly local bus pass
- Athletic Membership
- Library access
- On-campus internet access
- U of Guelph email address
- Insurance

Activities

Orientation:

During the first week, participants will be officially welcomed and introduced to key areas of the English Language Program, the university, and City of Guelph

Canadian Cultural Activities: sample of activities

- Day trip to Niagara Falls (with nominal fee)
- Orientation Social activity no fee
