Program Objectives:

- Improve academic English language skills in areas of: speaking and listening and academic writing
- Enhance knowledge of Canadian culture, inter-cultural communication



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Course Description:

Program: first week of arrival will be Orientation for the English Language Certificate Program students:

- Orientation-Campus tours, City of Guelph tours, Academic orientation, What to expect, Cultural shock, social activity, etc.
- English language Placement Test
- Students will be placed into the English Language Certificate Program with diverse student class

Program: Second week of arrival, classes begin for the English Language Certificate Program:

- Weekly classes
- 4 classes in Reading, Writing/Grammar, Listening, and Speaking
- One hour of Conversation Peer meetings with university students per week
- Learning materials (textbooks sold separately)
- Activities, volunteering, and social events (face-to-face)
- Airport transportation (return) with 5 or more students
